Spring Valley's grounds and facilities will transition to our 'winter' hours starting November 1st through the end of March. We continue to offer a full schedule of family, youth, and adult programs.

- Spring Valley's grounds and walking trails are open for walkers every day from 8am-5pm.
- Additional parking at St. Matthew Catholic Church will be available throughout the winter months. The gate leading onto Heritage Farm's walking paths from St. Matthew will be opened each morning at 8am.
- The Nature Center Museum is open to visitors daily from 10am-4pm (closed Nov. 27, Dec. 25, and Jan. 1).
- Volkening Heritage Farm's buildings are open Wednesday-Sunday from 10am-4pm through the end of November. They will reopen in April.
- Bison's Bluff Nature Playground will remain open daily from 10am-4:00pm at no charge through the end of March. The nature playground will be closed whenever unsafe conditions exist (snow, ice, rain, or temperatures below 32°F).
- Spring Valley has two picnic shelters available for private rental. These are located just east of the Nature Center parking lot and near Merkle Cabin. Requests for rentals need to be submitted at least two weeks in advance. Rates are based on residency.
- Volunteers continue to assist with outdoor conservation projects, garden and trail maintenance, youth summer camps, and with our events and programs. If you are willing and able to assist with projects, please contact Jeff Pal at jepal@parkfun.com

Spring Valley App

Staff maintains a site-use app for use on either Android or Apple smartphones. It features not only information on hours, site features, and facilities, but two guided tours that provide information on various natural history or historical topics as you walk the trails. Nature Center Construction Alert

The construction that was anticipated to begin during the month of November has been delayed till late winter/early spring. This work would affect the façade and offices at the Nature Center.
